

## **Guidelines for HAG HaHAGGADAH: A Creative Festival 5769**

1. **GOAL:** Create your own Haggadah which includes the traditional Seder elements in Hebrew, English and/or vernacular transliteration.

c. Other software editions have their own text libraries including the Haggadah which you can edit, illustrate, supplement, translate, transliterate, illuminate, format, etc. as you wish. All to my knowledge can be exported in a PDF for submission to this Festival. Other languages for translation, commentary and transliteration will be considered and judged found if possible – especially including Hebrew-only Haggadot for yeshivot, day schools and Israeli institutions.

2. You may submit your entry **only in a PDF**. It may be composed in any software and in any operating system of your choice, including but not limited to Davkewriter6 Platinum for the PC, Mellul for the Mac, Dagesh, Microsoft Hebrew Windows, or others. Judges will consider only a PDF submission - no other format including snail mail will be considered for judging.

3. Each entry must be accompanied with a JNF contribution confirmation number that you will receive when you make a contribution for a tree in Israel via JNF. In addition to the eligibility for this contest you are also planting a tree - at least one - in your name in Israel. JNF will provide you with each individual confirmation number that must accompany each separate submission and registration.

Copyrighted material from any source - books, internet textual, photo or graphic - must have written permission affirmed to be used. **We encourage you create and use original** artwork, photos, bibliographies, songs, graphics, scans, and texts for *translations, comments, commentary(ies) footnotes, endnotes, etc.*

6. First prize in each division will be

(a) a laptop computer;

(b) additional prizes will include books and computer software;

(c) all entries will be shared with interested publishers, and it will then be an individual negotiation between only the author(s) and the publisher;

(d) FFFE/Hag HaHAGGADAH retains the right to post the PDF in our website with full attribution to the creative author(s) and to use each entry for any other purpose to sustain FFFE/Hag HaHAGGADAH projects.

(e) we will advise you of new prizes on a regular basis at our up-date site.

8. The divisions for which each has a first prize of a laptop computer are:

(1) Elementary School grades K through 8;

(2) High School grades 9 through 12;

(3) College and adult
